

First Aid Certification Fund

1. First Aid Certification Fund

1.1. This fund is meant to help QNL members pay for first aid (re)certification courses.

1.2. This fund is only available on courses that lead to an accredited Europe-recognised first aid certification.

1.2.1. Only full or complementary certifications will be considered, no abridged/mini versions.

1.3. To request a compensation from the First Aid Certification Fund, fill out a First Aid Certification Fund Application.

1.3.1. The form is available on the QNL website, or by request through sending an email to contact@quidditchnederland.nl with the subject line "First Aid Certification Fund".

1.3.2. Fund requests can be send in before the completion of a course, to check whether the request is likely to be accepted after completion.

1.3.3. Application does not guarantee the receiving of any form of compensation.

1.4. On successful application, QNL will refund a maximum of 50% of the costs of the course, up to an amount of 50 euros.

1.4.1. Members are only allowed to receive money from the fund a maximum of one time a season, and only for one course at a time.

1.4.2. Refunds will not be awarded until after the successful completion of a course, with a copy of the certification as proof of completion.

1.5. To encourage the spread of first aiders through QNL, a maximum of 1 person per team per season can receive refunds through the First Aid Certification Fund.

1.5.1. Any subsequent requests from people out of the same team will be put on a waiting list. If nearing the end of the season there is still money left in the budget, QNL may decide to compensate people from the waiting list.

2. General Fund Clauses

2.1. QNL reserves the right to decline any fund request, without having to provide a reason.

2.2. Fund requests are usually considered on a first come, first serve basis.

2.3. At the discretion of the QNL Congress, fund requests may continue to be accepted and/or granted after the initially budgeted funds run out, or fund requests may stop being accepted and/or granted before the budgeted funds run out..

2.4. Initial reactions to fund requests can take up to ten days.

Note: Many insurance providers help pay for the costs of first aid trainings. Check your specific insurance to find out if this is an option for you.
